COMPETITION SCHEDULE

Women's Seniors Netball Winter Seasons run 28th April — 29th Sept for a total of 22 weeks including finals.

Mixed Seniors Netball Winter Seasons run 1st May — 25th Sept for a total of 22 weeks including finals.

COMPETITION FEES

Registration fee for Netball Seniors is - \$230 per player (netball insurance included)

Please note that all participants **MUST** hold a valid PCYC membership in order to play.

FORFEIT FEES

Team forfeits will result in a fine of \$100. However, the pricing and charges will be under the club's discretion and will only be implied due to repeated occasions or late notices.

Forfeits will result in a deduction of 3 points.

UNIFORMS

Teams will be required to have their own bibs/patches. Matching uniforms such as shirts will not be necessary.

Additionally, utilising PCYC equipment will result in a \$30 fee. However, when facing the challenge of two teams having the same-coloured bibs, Hawkesbury PCYC will be able to provide bibs – free of charge.

HOW TO REGISTER

All PCYC competition registrations, game times, fixtures and results are done through **SportFix.net**

All registration must be completed prior to the cut-off dates (this is displayed on the registration page).

Simply search the link below to access the FIXI registration page for your PCYC club.

- Create an account (if you have not already).
- Enter venue name: 'PCYC Hawkesbury'
- If you are the team delegate, please select **'register team'** and complete the form. This will then allow you to send your players a unique code to join your team.
- From here, select your desired competition and division to register in and continue through to payment.
- If your team is already set up, select **'join team'** and enter your unique code.

RESULTS AND FIXTURES

All PCYC Competitions game time, results and Ladder will be logged and updated on **SportFix Online**.

It is recommended that all team members download the **SportFix** app to stay up to date with their fixtures, results and game times.

GENERAL INFO

Competitions will run for a total of 22 games including finals. Whereby Netball times are 6:35pm, 7:20pm, 8:05pm & 8:50pm.

Game times will run as 4 x 9-minute quarters

- with 1 minute quarter breaks & a 2-minute half time break.

All players **MUST have a VALID PCYC membership** to be able to take the court. PCYC staff have the right to refuse entry and/or participation in sports competitions if players DO NOT have a valid PCYC membership.

Players from the age of 13. Whereby players under 18 will require parent's consent.

Teams have a maximum of 2 fill-ins per game and must have a minimum of 3 original players per game.

Teams must have a minimum of 5 players to take the court. Fill-ins cannot be used as spare players and only to be used to fill a team.

Fill ins **CANNOT** play a shooting position.

During a mixed game, male players must be in the correct zones and cannot have more than one male player in each zone. These zones are

- GS & GA
- WA, C & WD
- GK & GD

No jewelry is to be worn AT ANY TIME during games.

The ONLY EXCEPTION a taped wedding ring and medical alert bracelet.

Any other piercings worn **MUST** have a valid medical certificate stating the reason it must be worn
