Events:

- Women's (18+) Commences Monday September 2nd 6pm - 8pm
- Men's (18+) Commences Tuesday September 3rd 6pm - 8pm
- Youth (15-17 years) Commences Thursday September 5th 6pm - 8pm

How To Register:

- Team Delegate to fill out team nomination form and hand in/email to PCYC Liverpool.
- All players need to be current PCYC Members. \$15 for juniors or \$30 for adults.

Competition Information:

- Competition will run for 10 weeks (not during school holidays unless catch up games are required)
- Competitions will play the semi-final the week of November 25th 6pm – 9pm
- Teams must play a minimum of 5 games to qualify for finals.

Competition Fees:

- \$600 Registration per team.
- All fees are due before your first game of competition.

Competition Rules:

- 3 points for a win, 2 points for a draw and 1 point for a loss.
- Forfeits receive no points.
- The team who won on a forfeit will receive a 5-0 win.
- Women's Competition Monday 6-8pm
- Youth (14-16 years)- Tuesday 6-8pm
- Men's (17 years and over)- Thursday 6-8pm

Team and Players Information:

- Minimum 7 players (allows for 2 subs)
- Maximum 10 players (allows for 5 subs)

Team Delegate:

- A team delegate must be nominated on the team nomination form with complete contact details.
- In the event of a forfeit or any correspondence, the team delegate will be contacted by PCYC.
- It will be the responsibility of the delegate to pass all correspondence onto their team.

Game Duration:

- Games are 12-minute halves with 2-minute half time break.
- Game Times:
 1. 6:00pm - 6:25pm
 2. 6:30pm - 6:55pm
 3. 7:00pm - 7:25pm
 4. 7:30pm - 7:55pm

Sign on:

- All players must 'sign on' on the score sheet before the start of a game by placing their shirt number next to their name.
- Late players must sign on before entering the court.
- The score sheet is located at the reception desk before each game, games will not commence without all participating players signed on.
- Borrowed players must sign on and indicate which team they are registered in. Borrowed players must be identified to match officials.

Competition Points:

Win = 3 Points Draw = 2 Points Loss = 1 Point Forfeit = 0 Points

Uniforms:

- All players in each team must wear matching jerseys/playing strip with clearly visible numbers,
- Goalkeepers must wear a different coloured shirt to differentiate between other players.
- Shin pads with full-length socks must be worn.
- One goal will be awarded to the opposing team, for every player out of uniform.
- Shoes must either have rubber studs or no studs – metal studs are not permitted.

Forfeits:

- A team must inform PCYC of their intent to forfeit as soon as possible.
- Teams forfeiting 3 or more times in a season will not be allowed to register for the next season's competition unless a vacancy still exists after all other expressions of interests are placed.

Teams being Forfeited to:

- The team delegate will be notified by phone if the team's opposition intent to forfeit.
- A 5-0 win will be scored.
- Teams may be contacted in relation to moving timeslots in the case of forfeits.
- PCYC Liverpool reserves the right to waive forfeit penalties in extenuating circumstances.

Borrowing Players:

- A team may only borrow a maximum of 1 registered player under the following circumstances:
 - If a team has 4 originally rostered players on the court, then a maximum of 1 registered player can be borrowed making a total of 5 players on the court.
 - Teams cannot borrow other registered players if there are already 5 players on the court.
 - Goal keepers may be borrowed for normal round games, but not for finals

Starting Games:

- The game clock will start on time when referees are ready.
- If one team is not ready, they will be penalized 1 goal for every FULL minute they are late.
- Maximum 10 goals

Finals:

- Teams will play 1 week of finals.
- A player must have played 3 games in their registered team to be eligible to play in the finals
- Players cannot be borrowed for finals.
- Finals will follow a top 4 format, with division split into blocks of 4 where possible.
- Semi – finals will be sudden death fixtures where 1 vs 4 and 2 vs 3 with winner playing each other in the final.

Penalties:

- Straight Red Card (violent or aggressive conduct) = Minimum 2x week suspension. Referees have the ability to eject any player and/or spectators acting outside the code of conduct
- Straight Red Card (non-violent conduct e.g. Handball denying obvious goal scoring opportunity) = 0-1 weeks suspension – pending referee report on how deliberate offence occurred.
- Red Card after two Yellow Cards = 1 week suspension (pending referee report more weeks may apply)
- 5 Yellow Cards = 1-week suspension
- 8 Yellow Cards = 2-week suspension
- 2 Straight Red Cards (violent or aggressive conduct) over one season = season or indefinite suspension from PCYC run competitions (pending severity of referee's report on two offences)
- Suspensions can apply for off the court incident at the centre; you are responsible for your actions and behaviour at all times.

Challenges:

- Any challenges made by a team towards another team i.e. suspected unregistered players playing or other match disputes must be done through competition staff as soon as possible, preferably at the start of the game.

Complaints Procedure:

- Teams that wish to lodge a complaint must do so in writing by completing a match report form.
- Forms are available from reception upon your request.
- Complaints not completed through this process will not be considered.
- Teams and players that confront staff, other players or match officials will face suspension or even expulsion from the competition.
